

HARCREST PARK, PENN TOWNSHIP BUTLER COUNTY

Harcrest Park located at the intersection of Three Degree and Brownsdale Roads in Penn Township. It is a beautiful 49 acre parcel that was acquired by the Township through a generous donation by the Dale Hartzell family, a grant from Pa. DCNR and from Township funds. The Park is in its infancy and much work is ahead to reach the final "master plan." Right now, the paved trails are grass, the drive through the park only goes a few hundred feet, the structures only consist of one gazebo and there is no playground equipment. There is a lot to be done and the Park Committee has been slowly accomplishing what it can with the resources available relying mostly on donated materials, trees and manpower. Items of need would be pavilions, restrooms, gazebos, playground equipment, benches, and trees and of course, funds.
