Discussion:

- Penn Township will apply for the Act 89 of 2013 PA Vehicle Registration \$5.00 Local Use Fee grant funding for the Route 8 at Airport Road Traffic Light Replacement project.
- PennDOT Municipal Services representative, Cory Schaffer, explained the application for approval Form nos. MS-329 and MS-339. These forms are required for this grant application.
- Cory Schaffer provided copies of these forms to Linda Zerfoss and will assist with Penn Township's form submission.
- Sam Ward and Cory Schaffer also discussed the future need for a traffic light at the intersection of Route 8, Church Road, and Brownsdale Road. Cory Schaffer recommended that Penn Township set aside designated funds for the traffic engineering costs before requesting a PennDOT traffic study at this intersection and that construction would be dependent upon available grant funding. Cory Schaffer will provide the PennDOT contact information for requesting the future traffic study.
