Discussion:

- Trans Associates:
 - Trans Associates reviewed the traffic light drawings, dated March 8, 2023.
 - Trans Associates will resubmit the traffic light drawings with minor corrections and the luminaires to PennDOT on May 1, 2023.
- Brightspeed:
 - Brightspeed, Armstrong Utilities, and two other utilities will complete the planned move of the communications lines from two existing communication poles at the Southwest corner of the intersection to the adjacent First Energy poles. The existing communications poles will then be removed.



- This work is planned to be completed by the end of June 2023.
- Penn Township:
 - Once PennDOT approves the revised traffic light drawings, the traffic light replacement project will be advertised for bid.
 - It is anticipated that a bid would be awarded in approximately two months and that the construction would be completed in approximately ten months after the contract is awarded.
- The meeting concluded at 8:10 am.
