Penn Township's annual Community Day is set for August 17 at Harcrest Community Park. Entertainment will include pony rides and a petting zoo courtesy of Reichhold Farms, bouncy houses, a dunk tank, hay wagon rides from Dan Wible, and a rain gutter regatta race and ring toss games organized by Boy Scouts of America Troop 53.

The event begins at noon with a flag opening ceremony by Troop 53 and concludes at 3:45 p.m. with a flag closing ceremony.
