To obtain your criminal history please do the following:

3. In the center of the page click on "Criminal History Request"
4. Follow the directions for either 1 or 2

Bring a copy of the criminal history to the Penn Township Police Department. Applicants who give false information in the application or have been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude or have been convicted of disorderly conduct shall not be issued a license permit.

The approval or denial of an application shall be given within 72 hours after receipt of the application and criminal history.

Upon approval applicants will need to pay a sum of \$25.00 to Penn Township.

No license/permit will be issued until all fees are paid.
