Homeowner Occupied Rehabilitation

The programs are open to all income-eligible, single-family, owner-occupied residents in Butler County. Funding may be used for a variety of improvements to your home including: windows, roofs, electric, plumbing, heating and obvious structural defects. Funding is limited and not all eligible residents are guaranteed assistance.

Note: Programs and funding are subject to change.

Emergency Repair

This program's annual budget is funded by the County of Butler and is designed to assist low-income homeowners to receive a grant of up to \$2,500 in eligible emergency repairs in order to bring their home into compliance with health and safety issues. All homes must be located within the County of Butler. Eligibility requirements entail proof of home ownership, verification of all household income and an inspection constituting an eligible, emergency situation.

Weatherization

The programs under this category are funded by various sources such as: Department of Community and Economic Development, US Department of Energy, and/or various utility companies. The goal of weatherization is to assist low to moderate income homeowners/renters in decreasing their home energy consumption and costs by making necessary updates to their homes. Eligible applicants will receive grants to make their homes more energy efficient.

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FAIR HOUSING ANNOUNCEMENT

TO ALL RESIDENTS OF BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

THE COUNTY OF BUTLER ADVISES THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE CONSIDERED DISCRIMINATORY IF BASED ON RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, ANCESTRY, FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN OR HANDICAP:

- **REFUSING TO RENT TO, DEAL OR NEGOTIATE WITH ANY PERSON**
- **DISCRIMINATING ON TERMS OR CONDITIONS FOR BUYING OR RENTING HOUSING**
- **DISCRIMINATING BY ADVERTISING THAT HOUSING IS AVAILABLE ONLY TO PERSONS OF A CERTAIN RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, ANCESTRY, FAMILIAL STATUS OR HANDICAP**
- **DENYING THAT HOUSING IS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION, SALE OR RENT WHEN IT IS AVAILABLE**
- **BLOCKBUSTING FOR PROFIT, PERSUADING OWNERS TO SELL OR RENT HOUSING BY TELLING THEM THAT MINORITY GROUPS ARE MOVING INTO THE NEIGHBORHOOD**
- **DENYING TO ANYONE THE USE OF OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY REAL ESTATE SERVICES, MULTIPLE-LISTING SERVICES OR OTHER FACILITIES RELATED TO THE SELLING AND RENTING OF HOUSING**
